

Carson Sarcoma Foundation Donor Bill of Rights

The Donors will be informed of the organization's mission, of the process the organization intends to use to effectively direct donor funds, and of its capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes. The Carson Sarcoma Foundation (CSF) is formed and will function on funding those research efforts and trials that have promise to bring targeted therapies to cure Orphan Sarcoma Cancers.

All Governance and administrative costs will be communicated to the donor community. By utilizing volunteer based, experienced, educated and passionate board members and advisors who personally appreciate the devastating nature of the disease and the need for a cure, our internal costs should be held to \$0. The identity and capability of those serving on the board will be communicated to the donor community, giving them confidence in the foundation.

The placement of donor funds, the progress of the research and clinical trials will be clearly communicated to the donor community.

Financial Statements will be made available quarterly. Audited financial statements will be available to donors annually.

Donor directed contributions through CSF will be clearly publicized at the wishes of the Donor. Results will be monitored quarterly, with annual on-site audits by experienced board and/or advisor personnel.

At the wishes of our donors, recognition of their contributions as well as their contribution to results will be reported to them and publicly announced.

CSF will honor donor confidentiality requests.

CSF will be completely transparent in Governance processes, donations, and results. Any changes to the mission, governance, processes, contributions, will be made available to the donor community.
